

Objectives of the training

The MOSAIC reference module allows you to acquire all the neurophysiological and psychological bases of MOSAIC therapy, and to learn the reference protocol that will be used for all types of painful memories, traumatic memories, situations provoking strong emotions, ... This module is the prerequisite for all the specialization modules: complex trauma, depression, anxiety disorders (generalized anxiety disorder, panic disorder, phobias), OCD, addiction.

- Deepening the problem, understanding its dynamics and logic
